ABOUT ORIZIO

In June 2020, a brand-new aerospace ecosystem took off with Sabena Engineering and Sabca as pioneers, focusing on the sustainable development of the sector. The group was incorporated by SABENA AEROSPACE (holding company) and by the Sovereign Wealth Fund of Belgium (SFPIM).

Orizio group has continuously developed its activities during the 3 years following its creation, strengthening both of its companies with complementary activities, shared market knowledge and an optimized industrial organization.

Sabena Engineering reached a major milestone in its development through the take-over of Lufthansa Technik's line maintenance activities in Belgium and in several airports in the Europe-Middle East-Africa zone in 2021, and the merger with the F16 Center of Excellence in Charleroi (formerly Sabca) in 2022.

In parallel, Sabca further implemented its strategy as designer and integrator of plug and play aerostructures for the aviation and space markets, with a continued focus on sustainability, while further developing its activities in the UAV market.

Both companies contributed strongly towards the development of Orizio Group, as well as opening up new horizons for the aerospace ecosystem.
